

RULES and REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF, CHSA, CHJA or NEHC rule books will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. To show in CHJA or NEHC Medal classes, riders **MUST** be members. In order to compete for CHSA, CHJA or NEHC annual year-end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHSA, CHJA or NEHC. A copy of the CHSA, CHJA or NEHC Rule Book, class specifications, Medal class specifications, and membership application are available at the show secretary's office and at www.chja.net; www.chsaonline.com; nehc.info.

1. Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Equitation classes to be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of horse.
2. Hunter championships will be awarded in accordance with USEF rules. Championship and Reserve ribbons will be awarded to two of the four horses which have acquired the most points performing over a hunter course. In addition to these points, only these four horses shall receive full points for ribbons won in under saddle classes. 1st - 6th awarded in all classes. Championship and Reserve will be awarded in all divisions.
3. The committee reserves the right to change or vary the courses at their discretion.
4. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if warranted.
5. Scratches will be accepted only with the veterinarian's or medical certificate at least one hour before classes begin. No other scratches will be allowed except at the discretion of management.
6. Office fee is \$20.00. All entries must be signed by the Owner, Trainer and Rider (or Parent/Guardian) prior to numbers being released. Entries close 48 hours prior to show. Post entries will be accepted at an additional \$20.00 per horse.
7. A processing fee of \$25.00 shall be charged for each non negotiable check. Any exhibitor leaving the show with unpaid entry fees will be billed for these charges and a \$35.00 billing fee will be added to the total due.
8. All dogs must be leashed at ALL times.
9. Every animal entered for competition shall be under control of the committee, but Avon Valley Show Stables LLC will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor shall hold Avon Valley Show Stables LLC as well as the Show Committee harmless for any loss or accident which may occur. Should any question or dispute arise, it shall be referred to the show committee whose decision shall be final.
10. The horse show committee reserves the right to decline any entry, for any reason.

The following classes are rated as listed: The following classes are rated NEHC "C": NEHC Pleasure NEHC Medals:

NEHC OPEN ENGLISH PLEASURE:

Open to members and Non-members. Open to all horses ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to the status of rider or place of residence. To be shown at walk, trot or jog, canter or lope. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact. Will be required to back. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality, in that order. All horses shall be judged on their respective merits regardless of type.

NEHC Adult/Amateur Hunter Seat Medal

All exhibitors must present a valid membership card before the class, and show secretaries must record this number. A multiple day show (a show consisting of more than one day) may offer two Adult/Amateur Hunter Seat Medal Classes. If entries warrant – minimum of 16, management may split. There must be at least four (4) competitors in each class.

Open to adult amateur members of the New England Horseman's Council. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course.

Special Note: for the finals for the NEHC adult/amateur hunter seat medal, the judge shall be required to work-off the top four contestants.

NEHC Junior Hunter Seat Medal Class

Age Division: under 18 c239

All exhibitors must present a valid membership card before the class, and show secretaries must record this number. All contestants must wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified, they are no longer eligible for the qualifying classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for finals for that year. A multiple day show (a show consisting of more than one day) may offer two Hunter Seat Medal Class. If entries warrant – minimum 20, management may split. NOT divided by age. There must be at least four (4) competitors in each class. Open to Junior members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their eighteenth birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. Special Note: for the finals for the hunter seat medal, the Judge shall be required to work-off the top four contestants.
